Course Description

HCC267—Longwick 25 Miles

Start in the lane from Aston Sandford to A.4129 opposite the centre of the Bucks C.C. sign in a lay by approximately 1Km from the A.4129

Proceed in a south-east direction to the junction with A4129, where left to start a circuit

Go east on A4129 to the Sportsman Roundabout in Longwick

Turn at roundabout, and follow A4129 west to the roundabout at the Thame ring-road.

Turn left, to the Chinnor Road roundabout, where turn.

Retrace, and turn right at roundabout to rejoin A4129

Continue on A4129 for just over 3 miles to complete circuit

Repeat circuit, by continuing to Sportsman Roundabout

Turn, and take A4129 to roundabout at Thame ring road

Left, to Chinnor road roundabout, where turn

Retrace and turn right at roundabout, to rejoin A4129 and then complete second lap of circuit.

Continue, to finish at a point opposite a drain cover on south side of road, 60 yards past sign indicating layby in 275 yards, and approximately 200 yards before large layby west of Longwick.

Marshals referred to in this course description (M1, M2) etc may be provided solely to indicate the course direction.
They have no role whatsoever in the risk assessment itself.

No	Location	Perceived Risk	Level	Action Required
1	Start	Traffic passing riders waiting to start	MEDIUM	Place warning sign before start. All officials to wear Hi-Viz upper garments . Riders to wear Hi Viz numbers on their backs. Riders attention to be raised to traffic movement at time of their start. Riders waiting to start must keep off highway .
2	Turn RAB at junction with B4009 and A4129	Traffic on B4009 in each direction and A4129 approaching RAB being unaware of cycling event	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on each road approaching RAB to alert drivers of situation.
3	RAB at junction of A4129 B4012 and East Street	Traffic on A4129 heading South, North of RAB and on East Street heading East being unaware of cycling event	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on each road approaching RAB to alert drivers of situation.
4	Turn RAB at junction of B4012 with B4445	Traffic on B4445 in each direction and on B4012 heading East being unaware of cycling event.	MEDIUM	Place warning sign on each road approaching RAB to alert drivers of situation.
5	Finish	Danger from passing vehicles	LOW	All officials to wear Hi-Viz upper garments . Riders to continue past finish without stopping . A finish chequer board or flag is to be displayed at finish. It must be fixed to ensure it is not affected by passing traffic.
	Wherever placing or removing signs	Danger from passing vehicles	MEDIUM	Be very vigilant of traffic conditions It is strongly recommended that sign erectors wear Hi-Viz upper garments complying with BS EN 1150, BS EN 471 or ISO EN 20471:2013

Side road junctions, the small junctions or entrances to farms/facilities (garages, cafés etc) that are not mentioned in this risk assessment have been considered, they are not considered significant to pose a risk and therefore have not been noted.
